

Ventura County Pride Volunteers Responsibilities and Expectations

Thank you for joining Diversity Collective Ventura County's volunteer force. Diversity Collective is the premier non-profit in Ventura County that is 100% dedicated to sourcing and resourcing the LGBTQ+ community and their allies.

Below is a description of what volunteering for Ventura County Pride entails along with expectations and responsibilities:

- All volunteers must complete the DCVC volunteer form and waiver prior to the event.
- Volunteers must execute their responsibilities in a professional manner at all times and maintain professional and courteous conduct with the public, staff, and other volunteers. This includes the use of appropriate language, pronouns, and names. DCVC staff will provide DCVC staff will provide additional training and directions as needed at the time of the event.
- Volunteers must act and dress accordingly as representatives and liaisons of DCVC. Hats and sunscreen are highly encouraged. For setup and breakdown shifts, closed toes shoes are required, and work gloves recommended. T-shirts and/or other volunteer identification will be provided by DCVC.
- Please refrain from drinking alcohol prior to your volunteer shift. Drinking alcohol, smoking, and/or vaping will be prohibited during your volunteer shift. Once your shift has ended and you have removed all volunteer identification, you will be able to enjoy the event as you see fit.

Expect a time commitment of 4-5 hours. If you choose to volunteer for multiple shifts, you will be required to take a minimum 30 min break in between. We do not encourage you to sign up for back-to-back shifts.

Upon arrival for your shift, please report to the Volunteer booth, located near the festival entrance, for check-in, work details, and directions to your assigned location.
